Patients experiences of adrenal crisis

Read online or request the article

"Addison's disease and adrenal crisis: A phenomenological study of the patient experience" recently published in Nursing Praxis.

The article is co-authored by Sarah Fostekew, a clinical nurse specialist (CNS) at Waikato Hospital, Patrea Andersen and Isaac Amankwaa.

Sarah describes her interest in the research as arising from her work as an endocrinology clinical nurse

specialist, observing patients with Addison's disease as they journey from diagnosis to managing day to day life.

"Because no one really knows about Addison's. I still get people [health professionals] saying like "What's that?" ... and I have to go through and try [to explain]..." study participant

"I was concerned that nursing and medical staff often struggled to identify and support patients with Addison's disease particularly when presenting acutely during an adrenal crisis which had a significant effect on the on the patient and whānau experience." Positionality statement of first author.

Three themes arose from the study, these explained participants' experiences—responding, adjusting and learning. Read the article for the full findings and the recommendations arising from the study.

Sarah's top tips for researching and publishing:

- For research: find a topic that interests you
- For publishing: Be prepared for it to take time from starting to write to publishing
- Don't fear rejection the feedback helps get you to where you need to be



Racism, early psychosis, and institutional contact

This study, examining the experiences of nine Māori youth with early psychosis, ten family members and four Māori mental health professionals, unravels the nature of racism and explores health impacts.

Racism is well recognised as an important social determinant of mental health.

Three major themes are described;

- selective responses based on racial stereotypes,
- race-related risk assessment bias and
- institutional racism in the mental health workforce.



Many managers believe they have to make a choice: be empathic and sacrifice their well-being for the good of others, or back away to preserve their own emotional health.




THE SOLUTION




